

# Prohibited & Restricted Goods

The shipper agrees and understands they must prepare their shipment so that it is acceptable for transportation as per the relevant international regulatory bodies, government body or other relevant organisation. A shipment is deemed unacceptable for transit if it contains Hazardous Material, Dangerous Goods, Prohibited or Restricted articles as defined by IATA (International Air Transport Association), ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organisation), ADR (European Road Transport Regulation on dangerous goods).

**Many items which appear harmless in everyday use can pose dangers on air and / or road transport and are consequently forbidden for transport.**

In the UK the CAA (Civil Aviation Authority) is the governing body responsible for compliance of these rules. Failure to follow requirements may endanger the aircraft, its occupants and result in the prosecution of the person responsible under the Air Navigation (Dangerous Goods) Regulations. Please be aware it is your responsibility to ensure the shipment is safe for transit and complies with International regulations.

## The Following Items are Classified as Dangerous & are NOT Permitted

Goods travelling by 'Cargo' (this shipment) are subject to different restriction to those travelling as carry-on luggage, as checked baggage (at the airport) or carried on your person at the flight.

Many items which appear harmless in everyday use can pose dangers on aircraft / road transport and are consequently forbidden for transport by Air Navigation (Dangerous Goods) Regulations 2010. Shipment by Road are subject to same restrictions (ADR Regulations)

In accordance with International Law (IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations) the goods listed below are classified as 'Dangerous' and not allowed for shipment by Air Navigation (Dangerous Goods) Regulations 2010. Please be aware these restrictions are also applicable to Road Freight.

All items are X-Rayed screened to check for compliance. If you have contravened these regulations and such items are found in your shipment, your shipment will be halted and you will be charged a fee by the handling agent or consolidator and the shipment will continue to be delayed until such charges have been paid in full. You will also incur a **£60 administration penalty**.

## The Following Items are Classified as Dangerous & are NOT Permitted

Please check the box and initial on the right hand side to show you understand that the following items are prohibited and not permitted in your shipment.



### All Oxidizing Substances & Organic Peroxides

Oxidising materials and organic peroxides e.g.: bromides, chlorates, components of fibreglass repair kits, disinfectants, nitrates, per chlorates, permanganates and peroxides, including bleach, hair dyes and colourants containing peroxide



### Toxic & Infectious Substances

Pesticides and Insecticides, Mercury, Poisons etc



### Corrosive Substances

All battery types, Corrosive cleaning fluids, Acids and Alkali's, Thermometers (mercury) etc



### Miscellaneous Dangerous Goods

Asbestos, Magnetized materials, Dry ice, Tools and power tools, Self inflating life jackets



### Explosives

Ammunition, Christmas crackers, Snaps, Fireworks, Fuses, Weapons or replicas



### Radioactive Materials

Fissile material (uranium 235, etc), radioactive waste material, thorium or uranium ores and luminous dials from aircraft.

## The following items are classified as restricted to some countries

# All Batteries are Prohibited by Air / Road Freight & Courier Services

**You must ensure that all batteries are removed from your consignment.** If batteries are detected during security X-Ray, your consignment will be refused carriage, and we will be required to collect your consignment back from the airline or courier carrier. Removal of batteries from your consignment will be subject to **a handling charge of between £60.00 and £120.00.** This handling charge will vary depending on the point at which batteries are detected. Batteries detected after we have delivered your consignment to the air carrier will attract the highest handling charge.



**WARNING:** Failure to comply with the terms of shipment laid out on to these pages will lead to the rejection of your shipment

Where charges are incurred for the removal of Non-Permitted or Restricted goods by an airline, handling agent, consolidator etc, these charges will be passed on to you together with a minimum £60 administration fee, and the shipment will be delayed until such charges are paid.

The customer hereby declares that their consignment contains none of the goods as described on this page and overleaf. Where such non permitted or restricted items are found, Excess Baggage Company reserves the right to remove these items and dispose of them without reference to the customer.

In such circumstances the customer will not be due for any compensation, nor will Excess Baggage Company be under any obligation to return or forward such items or give any notice that such items have been removed.
